In 2002, she moved back to White River and worked at Gus Stop for a number of years until she was not able due to health reasons.

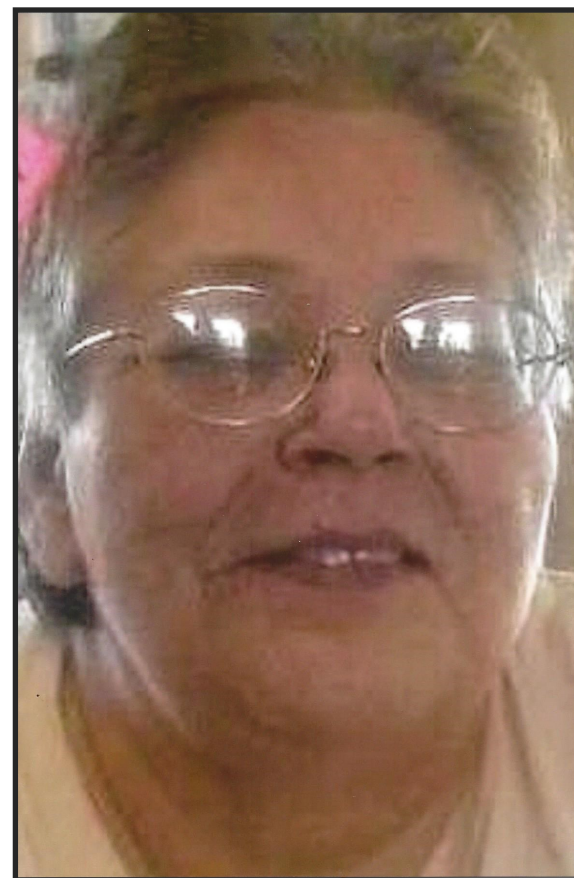
